REGULATION

ON THE PROCEDURE FOR THE COMPETITIVE SELECTION OF INNOVATIVE PROJECTS

"Skolkovo Cybersecurity Challenge"

1. Definitions and Abbreviations

2. General Provisions

2.1. This Regulation defines the objectives, tasks and order of Competitive Selection in Innovative Technological Cybersecurity Solutions. Cybersecurity is one of modern information trends which, inter alia, unites the following top priority research areas:

- New applications and infrastructure solutions to increase security of the Internet, engineering and business systems;
- New methods of increasing efficiency and security of existing communications including wireless and optical communications;
- New applications and infrastructure solutions to prevent cyberthreats, fraud and conduct cyberinvestigations;
- New applications and infrastructure solutions to protect data including in cloud and distributed environments;
- New biometric and identification systems;
- New methods and software designed for safe storage and secure transfer of data.

2.2. The Competitive Selection is made by Contest Organizers determined in paragraph 1 hereof.

2.3. The announcement of Competitive Selection terms is performed through the placement of a respective publication and this Regulation on the Internet, on the official page of the Competitive Selection: <http://cyber2015.sk.ru>.

2.4. The Organizers reserve the right (in their sole discretion) to cancel, to finish, to suspend or to extend the Competitive Selection as well as to change any terms and conditions of this Regulation at any time and for any reason, without incurring thereby any liability to Participants and other persons.

2.5. The Competitive Selection is not a public competition within the meaning of the term provided for in Article 1057 of the Civil Code of the Russian Federation.

2.6. Within the Competitive Selection it is allowed to introduce special nominations, in each of which a winner of the Competitive Selection can be selected.

2.7. An actual list of nominations is published on the official page of the Competitive Selection.

3. Objectives of the Competitive Selection

The main objectives of the Competitive Selection are:

- Promotion among Russian small and medium-sized innovative companies and research organizations of research and development of new technologies in areas that are in demand in the market;
- Development of the Skolkovo Innovation Center by attracting new Project Participants;
- Use of intellectual resources of Participants to address topical issues in the field of cybersecurity.

4. Participants

4.1. Participants with projects of research and development works aimed at the creation of innovative technologies in cyber- and information security are allowed to participate in the Competitive Selection.

4.2. A participant can be represented by an individual, a group of individuals or a legal entity having applied for participation in the Competitive Selection in accordance with the requirements of this Regulation.

5. Procedure of the Contest

5.1. A participant submits an Application to the Organizers via the website: <http://cyber2015.sk.ru> in accordance with requirements stated in Article 8.

5.2. The Contest is effected in two stages: Preliminary Selection and the Final.

5.3. Preliminary Selection is made by the Jury based on the following criteria:

5.3.1. A Project is aimed at creating or refinement technological solutions for cybersecurity (yes/no);

5.3.2. A Project meets at least one innovative priority of the Fund within the framework of Activity Areas ("Innovative Priorities"). The list of Innovative Priorities of the Fund is approved by an order of the Fund (yes/no);

5.3.3. A created product and/or technology has potential competitive advantages compared to world analogues (yes/no);

5.3.4. A created product and/or technology has a significant commercialization potential at least in the Russian and for the future - in the world market (yes/no);

5.3.5. A Project is theoretically feasible, is not conflicting with fundamental scientific principles (yes/no);

5.3.6. Key project researchers, developers and managers ("the Project Team") have knowledge, scientific or industrial experience and entrepreneurship skills required for the successful project implementation and related to the Project topic (yes/no);

5.3.7. Scientific and technical focus on innovation of the Project. Assessment in scores from 1 to 10, where 10 is the highest score;

5.3.8. A Project has a significant commercialization potential in the Russian Federation and abroad. Assessment in scores from 1 to 10, where 10 is the highest score.

5.4. Not more than 10 (ten) best project from the Competitive Selection will be selected during the Competitive Selection, and they shall meet the following conditions:

5.4.1. A Project stated in an Application received "YES" under subparagraphs 5.3.1 - 5.3.6 of most (more than a half) Jury members who participated in a respective Jury meeting;

5.4.2. A Project was granted the highest score in total by all Jury members under subparagraphs 5.3.7 - 5.3.8;

5.4.3. A decision is approved by voting by a simple majority of votes of Jury members who participated in the meeting;

5.4.4. In accordance with the Regulation on the Grant and Loss of the Status of a Participant of the Project for Establishing and Ensuring the Functioning of the Skolkovo Innovation Center existing as of the date of the Final of the Competitive Selection ("the Regulation on Status"), legal entities established under the Russian legislation and meeting requirements of part 2 Article 10 of Federal Law No. 244-FZ "On the Skolkovo Innovation Center" dated September 28, 2010, and paragraph 2 Article 1 of the Regulation on Status, that provided the Skolkovo Foundation with projects presented at the Competitive Selection by participants recognized as the best according to paragraph 5.7 hereof may apply to receive a Skolkovo Project Participant Status in accordance with the procedure set out in the Regulation on Status for such legal entities implementing projects recognized as the best following selections provided that such procedure will be specified in the Regulation on Status at the time of determination of Competitive Selection winners.

5.4.5. If all projects receive less than 4 scores by every criteria specified in paragraphs 5.3.7 - 5.3.8, the Jury shall recognise the Competitive Selection as failed;

5.4.6. Not later than two days after the Preliminary Selection the Organizer shall inform

Participants who were selected for the Final on the Competitive Selection's website;

5.4.7. Every Finalist will have at least 10 (ten) days to prepare a Questionnaire in accordance with Annex 3;

5.4.8. A Questionnaire shall be submitted in PDF or Word format to Organizers via the website <http://cyber2015.sk.ru> not later than the term specified in Article 6;

5.4.9. Participants who have not provided Questionnaires within the term specified in Article 4 are not allowed to participate in the Final of the Competitive Selection;

5.4.10. The Jury shall assess provided Questionnaires not later than within the term specified in Article 6 under the following criteria:

1) a unique product capable of changing the market structure in its segment in the world - is assessed with a score from 0 to 3, where 3 is the highest score;

2) quality of preparation of the Project business model - is assessed with a score from 0 to 3, where 3 is the highest score;

3) relevance of a Project Team as regards the stated Project - is assessed with a score from 0 to 3, where 3 is the highest score;

4) project feasibility in considered parameters (scientific feasibility, calculation of resources and terms, technological basis) - is assessed with a score from 0 to 3, where 3 is the highest score;

5) technological focus on innovation - is assessed with a score from 0 to 3, where 3 is the highest score;

5.5. Participants permitted to participate in the Final will be informed of the date, time, place and form of the Final of Competitive Selection not later than 10 days in advance.

5.6. During the Final, Finalists' pitch sessions should be conducted before the Jury by a Finalist who is an individual in person, a contact person of a Finalist who is a group of individuals or a contact person of a Finalist who is a legal entity.

5.7. Following the Competitive Selection, the Jury shall recognize individual Projects as the best using an average score for a project under assessment criteria described in Article 5.4.10 except for the case stated in paragraph 9.9 hereof. Not more than 25 per cent of projects stated in Applications for participation may be recognized as the best.

5.8. A list of winners is published on the website of the event: <http://cyber2015.sk.ru>.

6. Terms of the Competitive Selection

The Competitive Selection is carried out from May 26, 2015 till November 1, 2015 in accordance with the following schedule:

7. Partners of the Competitive Selection

7.1. A Russian or foreign organization participating in the Competitive Selection using one or several of the following options shall be deemed a partner of the Competitive Selection:

- establishment of special nominations and additional prizes from an organization;
- delegation of its representatives for mentor sessions during preparations for the Final of the Competitive Selection;
- information support of the Competitive Selection by distributing information on the Competitive Selection among its subsidiaries, partners, suppliers, contractors, etc.

7.2. The number of Partners of the Competitive Selection may be increased during the Competitive Selection.

7.3. An up-to-date list of Partners of the Competitive Selection is published on the website of the Competitive Selection <http://cyber2015.sk.ru>.

8. Requirements for Applications

8.1. An Application is submitted to the Organizers via the website <http://cyber2015.sk.ru>.

8.2. An Application is a set of documents describing the Project which includes:

- An Application for participation in the Competitive Selection in the form set out in Annex 1 hereto (carries out a function of the letter of intent to participate in the Competitive Selection);

- Description of the Project in the form of attachment to an Application (in MS Office Power Point format) in accordance with the presentation template located at <http://community.sk.ru/press/m/wiki/4297/download.aspx>;

- Additional documents required to assess an Application from the point of view of Participants.

- CVs of key project team members (in any format). The team should include professionals with necessary knowledge and experience for the successful Project implementation.

8.3. A Project should meet one or more of Priority Areas published on website <http://community.sk.ru/foundation/itc/p/directions.aspx>.

8.4. Information submitted in an Application shall be complete, accurate and reliable; it shall not violate the rights of third parties, including intellectual property rights.

8.5. The application must represent an original work of authorship and the Participant must have all the rights, permits and consents required to apply for the participation in the Competitive Selection.

9. Jury

9.1. The Jury is formed for the Competitive Selection and the members of the Jury are presented in Annex 2.

9.2. Jury members are engaged in the Competitive Selection free of charge.

9.3. The functions of the Jury include the assessment of Applications at the Preliminary Selection stage and determination of winners of the Competitive Selection.

9.4. A Jury member, who is an interested party in relation to any Participant, shall inform the Organizers thereof in the assessment bulletin of a corresponding Application, refraining from its assessment.

9.5. A Jury member is considered interested in relation to a Participant, if he/she gets (or can get) direct personal benefit in connection with the assessment of an Application.

9.6. Jury members can request additional information required for the assessment of an Application from Participants through the Organizers.

9.7. The assessment of Applications for the Competitive Selection by Jury members may, according to a decision of the Organizers, be performed both by correspondence and in person, including via invitation of Participants to present their Applications in person.

9.8. Winners in special nominations introduced by Partners are determined by Partners at their discretion.

9.9. When summing up the Competitive Selection, the Jury reserves the right to select no winners of the Competitive Selection.

10. Intention of the Skolkovo Foundation to conclude an agreement on the minigrant provision

The Skolkovo Foundation invites legal entities meeting criteria of paragraph 5.4.4 hereof and implementing Projects presented by persons recognized by the Jury as winners of the Competitive Selection, make proposals on agreements on the provision of minigrants to participants of the Project for Establishing and Ensuring the Functioning of the Skolkovo Innovative Project published on the Internet at the address: <http://sk.ru/news/m/wiki/8508/download.aspx>, on the terms of the Regulation on Grants, and a standard agreement on minigrant provision published on the Internet at the address: <http://sk.ru/news/m/wiki/9231/download.aspx>, the subject of which will be the provision of monetary funds on the target basis by the Skolkovo Foundation for the implementation of Projects recognized as the best following the Competitive Selection in accordance with paragraph 5.7 hereof to the specified persons in the following amount:

- to a legal entity meeting the criteria of paragraph 5.4.4 implementing the Project with the maximum average score under assessment criteria set in paragraph 5.4.10 hereof – not more than 5,000,000 rubles.

- to a legal entity meeting paragraph 5.4.4 implementing the Project with the second maximum average score under assessment criteria set in paragraph 5.4.10 hereof – not more than 4,000,000 rubles;

- to a legal entity meeting the criteria of paragraph 5.4.4 implementing the Project with the second maximum average score under the assessment criteria set in paragraph 5.4.10 hereof – not more than 3,000,000 rubles.

The Skolkovo Foundation intends to conclude agreements on the minigrant provision on the following terms:

- A legal entity intending to implement the Project presented by a Participant who was recognized as a winner of the Competitive Selection in accordance with the procedure stated in Article 5 hereof as of the moment of the minigrant provision that has a Skolkovo project participant status;

- A legal entity intending to implement the Project presented by a Participant who was recognized as a winner of the Competitive Selection as of the time of the minigrant provision, meets the requirements of the Regulation on Grants to Participants of the Project for Establishing and Ensuring the Functioning of the Skolkovo Innovative Center and the Skolkovo Foundation's Grant Policy published at the address: <http://community.sk.ru/net/participants/p/documents.aspx>;

- The provision of a Skolkovo Foundation's minigrant to a legal entity intending to implement the Project presented by a Participant that was recognized as a winner of the Competitive Selection is approved by the Skolkovo Foundation in accordance with the Regulation on Grants to Participants of the Project for Establishing and Ensuring the Functioning of the Skolkovo Innovation Center;

- The total amount of minigrants provided by the Fund to a Participant who is a Russian legal entity prior to the Competitive Selection and the amount of a Skolkovo Foundation minigrant provided to a winner of the Competitive Selection in accordance with paragraph 14.1 hereof cannot exceed 5,000,000 rubles if previously provided minigrants were given to implement a Project submitted for the Competitive Selection.

1.1 Amend sub 9.1. paragraph 9 as follows:

«The Jury is formed for the Competitive Selection and the members of the Jury are presented in Annex 2. Partners of the Organizer shall be entitled to notify the appointment of a replacement of an expert in the jury by sending to the Organizer e-mail address: it-cluster@sk.ru not later than 3 business days prior to the meeting of the Jury».
